

# Article submissions

Try to keep the text to 1,000 words or less. We like to get 1,000 word pieces that explain a technique or the history of a piece of music or instrument.

If you're not into writing, but want to highlight an arrangement you've written, please include a paragraph that tells readers an interesting fact about the piece, walks readers through playing a tricky measure, or that tell us a bit about you.

Send article submissions as a text document using Word or rtf. Use as little formatting as possible (no double spacing, spaces between paragraphs, indents or embedded graphics).

Always include a photo of you and a tagline with your article (see Photo and Tagline Submissions).
