

Photographs and illustration submissions

All photographs should be sent electronically at high resolution (300 ppi).

Accompanying every article or sheet music submission should be a high resolution photo (300 ppi) of you, preferably with your instrument.

If there is more than one photo, use a program such as Dropbox, Google Drive or WeTransfer as they will be large files.

Photographs should be named clearly. Include a Word or rtf document that pairs the photo's name with caption information and a photo credit (if you know who took the picture write *Photo by photographer*. If you don't know who took the picture write *Photo courtesy of your name*. Your caption should include as much information as possible. If you can identify everyone in the photo, please do so (from left to right; front row, row 2, row 3, etc.). If you can tell us when and where the photo was taken, that is also helpful. The more information you can give us, the better.

Graphics or illustrations that are appropriate to your article should be submitted as a pdf.

CD covers should be sent at a high resolution (300 ppi) and should be submitted with CD reviews and Song Sampler submissions.
